Fr. Tomosz's Weekly Reflection Deliberately taking the lowest place or to invite the poor, the

Deliberately taking the lowest place or to invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind, does not fit in the spirit of this world. There is a difference between self-deprecation and humility. The first is a sign of pride, which deliberately and demonstratively underestimates one's value for others to deny it. It is a mechanism focused on fishing for compliments and praise. Humility, on the other hand, is a trait of character that seeks true self-measure. When Saint Anthony received a vision of all the Satan's ambushes awaiting a man striving towards God he was terrified and asked God: "who will get through?" In reply, he heard: "Humility!" Humility is a power that no evil and no evil spirit can undermine.

Humility does not begin with great sacrifices, but with the smallest of steps. This is what Jesus says today: it is enough that you are not looking for the first place among other people; that you don't think you know everything; that in ordinary conversation you do not try to be original and infallible, bragging about your eloquence and erudition. One of the characteristics of pride is the desire to stand out, to manifest yourself as someone special, outstanding and knowing everything. Not taking first place does not only mean looking for the last chair at the meetings, but it also includes the ability to give up trying to force your own reason and striving to impress others. Pride is distinguished by self-expression, in clothing, in the way of being, even in the way of prayer. But also playing the role of someone other than who you really are.

Humility - one of the seven main virtues - is not about talking and thinking about yourself badly. Humility is a proper assessment of one's own abilities, without pretending you are worse than you really are. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says "The humble are not surprised by their distress; it leads them to trust more, to hold fast in constancy" (CCC 2733). Whoever is humble does not look at others with contempt, does not judge at first sight, does not categorize neighbors. Mistaken are those who believe that humility means being passive in conflict, giving in to others, giving up one's own opinion and goals, nodding and pleasing others. There's a Polish saying, "A humble calf sucks two mothers." This calf is not humble. It's clever, calculating, greedy and perfidious.

A truly humble person not only knows their place in life, not only knows what they can do and what goals they can set for themselves, but also consistently pursues them, rejecting false compromises, short-heartedness, cowardice, giving way to others "for the sake of peace." Humility does not allow selfishness but leads to concern for others. There is no love without humility; neither for God nor oneself nor for neighbor.
