Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

At Christmas, the Church experiences the joy of God who loved us so much that He became human in his Son. Therefore, decorated and illuminated Christmas trees, garlands of lights on the streets of cities and our homes seem to encourage us to join the cry: "Let us also go and greet the Lord."

In Bethlehem, the Savior of the world was born. This is the greatest grace and blessing for man, who can receive God's power directly from Baby Jesus.
