Fr. Tomas's Weekly Reflection

Jesus Christ is the King of the Universe because of His dignity, for His kingdom is above all others and surpasses them all, it is their prototype. And if He had walked our Earth this day and age, He would have probably used the advancements of technology to preach the Gospel, however, we can say with certainty, His words, gestures and deeds would reach us all with the same clarity.

Today Church wishes to make us aware of the fullness of life and happiness that is available to us in Christ Jesus, our Lord. He entered the glory of the Father, passing from death to life, in order to give us all a new courage to do good, to give us a glimpse of the glory of the eternal life, here on Earth. As we read in the Gospel passage, there is an explicit and unbreakable relationship between our deeds in this life, and the world to come, which we ultimately prepare for ourselves. Our God wants to offer us joy and happiness, not only in the Kingdom of eternal life, but He also desires our mortal lives to be better than we make them for ourselves, and certainly better than it is dictated by those who rule this earthly world. God wants our present lives - subjected to various trials of suffering and sorrow - to recover from degrading, enslaving sin, from the shadow of death. Through His loving providence, God wants us to know Him as the Father who always wants the best for His children. He desires us all to be fully aware that we belong to the Kingdom of Christ, His Son, and to respond to His call and cooperate in the building of a civilization of love, and in fulfilling His promises. Therefore, today's solemnity should make us unequivocally realize that Christ is the King of hearts, the King of goodness, love, unity, peace, the King of trust, hope, faithfulness, the King of transformation of this world at large, and of the internal life of every individual human being. Christ wants to build His Kingdom where people, with the use of their gifts, talents, and resources, are always ready and willing to help others in all situations and circumstances. He wants to build and enlarge His Kingdom in the hearts of those who serve Him.

Almighty and ever living God, who wanted to restore everything through Your Most Beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe; in Your goodness, make all peoples, divided by the tragedy of sin, submit to Your eternal power. Amen.
