Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection


Be watchful! Watch! These calls are repeated like a chorus in today's Gospel passage. To be watchful means first not to sleep, but also to stay alert, focused. Watchfulness can be shown in two different ways: internal - watching over oneself, personal awareness, and external - watching over the world, over people or property. The second aspect implies the presence of the first: one first needs to be awake, conscious, in order to take responsibility over something external. Both, however, need to be present in order for the watch to be effective, good and beneficial.

The vigilance Christ calls us to must harmoniously combine observance of one's own heart with the attentiveness to the world, especially the people close to us and assigned to us, given us to care for. Looking into the heart or examining one's conscience shows that sins are the moments when we lose our focus, get distracted, when we are not spiritually awake. On the other hand, we tend to be able to better watch over ourselves when we are aware that He, Christ the Lord, permeates our lives, lives with us and in us, and knows us.

When one is aware of himself in his relation to God, the external aspect of staying awake, watching the world around, guarding it, has nothing to do with simplistically understood governance, being in charge, rebuilding or reformatting it according to one's own heart. Taking care of the world around is not about giving it a new direction, but rather recognizing where is its goal and destination that God himself assigned to it. This destination, the end point of the world, is the moment of the return to the Creator, but also the return of the Creator.

The awareness of the ultimate destination, of the reunion between the world and its Creator, the preparedness for the Master's return, sets the standards for our lives' goals and the direction of the development of the world. This knowledge allows me to not be afraid of the terms like virtualization, globalization, economization and any other "-ations" or "-isms", but rather give them a new meaning, aligned with the Lord's desire for this world. It reveals to us that they express the requirement of guarding the good entrusted to us, that is, watching over the life of the communities in which we participate: families, parishes, homes, cities, countries, continents, and the Church. The watchfulness becomes the recognition that life is not a lonely walk, but a walk in which we go with others, hand in hand.

Ultimately, this vigilance must be aimed at something or someone. Our watchfulness – both the one directed internally towards the heart and the one focused on the world is to be summarized by one disposition: waiting for the Lord. Just like we say every day: Thy kingdom come!
