

## Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

We are deeply rooted in our everyday life. We are consumed by our obligations and attachments. We are concerned about the economy and politics. We want, we seek, we win and we lose. Our days pass so imperceptibly With our eyes focused on the present, we rarely think about eternity. But it will inevitably come one day.

Today's liturgy reminds us of this. Saint Peter teaches that the day of the Lord will come like a thief, unexpectedly. The entire order of this world will be destroyed, and there will be a new heaven and a new earth; justice will reign in the world. We can add similarly that there will be no more sickness, suffering, toil and death. All evil will be eradicated.

As Christians, we should look forward to this day. We hope that God will want wipe every tear from our eyes, as we say in the Mass when the 3rd Eucharistic Prayer is used. Therefore, believers in Christ should not fear that day, as long as they are, of course, prepared for this moment. After all, every day we ask God in prayer saying "Thy kingdom come".

The liturgy of the second Sunday of Advent reminds us that we are not only of this world, but that we already are citizens of heaven through baptism. We should be looking forward to returning to the Father's house, and happily listen to the prophet's promises: *Here comes with power the Lord GOD, who rules by his strong arm; here is his reward with him, his recompense before him.* We should live in such a way that we can always say that we are prepared for this moment. That is why we hear the words of Isaiah three times today: *Prepare the way for the Lord.* One would like to say: let's throw away all sneers and self-interested calculations, let's reject all infidelity to God's law. Let's convert. Let us live in the simplicity of the Gospel.

An example of this attitude is the prophet of Advent - John the Baptist. The things of this world did not matter to him. He humbly proclaimed the coming of one stronger than himself, whom he was not worthy to untie the thong of his sandals. We too must humbly put Jesus first. It is the most sensible thing we can do. For everything passes away, and only the good that we do here on earth carries on with us to the eternity. Therefore, it is worth applying in our lives the words of St. Augustine: "If you love life, desire the life that never ends."




St. Peter's has generously donated \$2,000 to the Catholic Communications Campaign.
