# Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

Today Church celebrates the Epiphany, that is, the revelation of Jesus to the world. The peoples of all the world, of all languages and countries, who, called by the Lord, set out on the way to adore the Newborn in Bethlehem are represented in the persons of the Magi.

The wise men are led by the star that encourages them along the way and illuminates the path for them. On the other hand, the priests and scribes, those who know the prophecies and should be on their toes seeing the Bethlehem Star, maybe have even passed by the manger on their way to Jerusalem, not realizing what was happening.

Priests and scribes know the Scripture well. That's why when asked they are quick to respond that Bethlehem is indicated as the birthplace of the promised King of Israel. But they cannot tell Herod anything more than mere information contained in the books of the Word of God, they know it but don't understand it.

We are dealing with a kind of paradox. On one hand, we see the mysterious star that brings about an encounter between pagan Magi and the King of Kings. In contrast, we have those who receive the Word of God directly, but read it in such a way that it doesn't bring them any closer to Him. This is why they couldn't give Herod any more information than just to quote from the Scripture.

Today's Liturgy of the Word is full of signs that can lead one to God, as long as they allow themselves to be led obediently. We learn today that it is important to observe in our everyday life those signs through which God speaks to us, calls us and guides us. The wise men not only followed the sign of the Star in the East, but also, in recognition of Jesus' kingship, presented Him with royal gifts: gold, frankincense and myrrh. Gold symbolized what is beautiful, glorious and valuable. It points out to Jesus' dignity as a king. Frankincense was used in temples during sacrifices as a symbol of prayer, lifting to God like the smoke it produces. This gift indicated that Jesus is someone even greater, that He is God. Myrrh is a balm used to anoint the dead, but also added to wine to strengthen it. Such a drink was served to the convicts. It foreshadows the Lord's passion and burial. In those signs Jesus is recognized as king, as God, and as man.


In the end, the Gospel specifies that the Magi, after meeting Jesus, *departed for their country by another way*. Such a re-routing represents the conversion to which those who encounter Christ are called. But in order to experience such a conversion, we first need to truly encounter the Christ.
