



Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

In each of today's Scripture readings we hear a message regarding family, parents, children, that is, regarding all of us, regarding those who were, are or will be family, without exception. Because no matter how you look at life, each of us remains a child and almost each of us is or will be a parent, depending on the circumstances: biological, by adoption, or spiritual.

This Sunday celebration teaches us about the rights of the father and mother, about the rights of children; tells us how to show gratitude and kindness to parents, and above all — even if not literally then between the lines - shows us how to show gratitude to the Father by whom and through whom everything has come to existence. We are also provided with a valuable encouragement, when we hear that thanks to our love, respect and kindness we can gain forgiveness of sins, because *kindness to a father will not be forgotten*.

Today the Church presents us with the Holy Family as the model of the life of every Christian family. Joseph's paternity (admittedly adopted) is somewhat underrated. Saint Joseph, a God-fearing, just, honest and reliable man, despite fear of the legal consequences of his actions, according to the Mosaic Law, became the earthly father of the Son of God. This great man also – like his betrothed - answered to God's call with his own Fiat.

On the other hand, it is quite straight forward for us to acknowledge the Blessed Virgin Mary who became pregnant through the Holy Spirit, when the power of the Most High overshadowed her; who gave birth to the Son of God, answering Yes to God's invitation to her participation in the History of Salvation: Let it be done to me...

Finally, we are given an image of a perfect, obedient Son, who remaining in God's grace becomes *strong*, *filled with wisdom*. In the Gospel, Saint Luke teaches us how to care for the faith of our children and how to lead them on the path of God's favor. He recognizes that the faithfulness of the parents is the source of the faithfulness of children.

Life of a family must be planned with God in mind. We have to invite Him to the family table, family talks, decisions, family care for every one of its members. With Him we have to bend over the sick, cook meals, help one another, plan our time, activities or rest. If this is forgotten, if God is not allowed into the daily life of a family, that family will sooner or later become weak, lacking understanding for one another, and thirsting for love – a spiritual desert.
