

Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

From the moment we come into this world, our whole life – whether we are aware of it or not – is a time of anticipation. From the beginning of existence, all creatures await the coming of the Lord. We live in a continuous Advent. However, this anticipation takes on a special character in the four weeks leading up to the celebration of Christmas.

In the first reading, prophet Jeremiah exclaims: *The days are coming, says the LORD, when I will fulfill the promise I made to the house of Israel and Judah,* indicating that because of God's faithfulness to His promise, He will be recognized as *the Lord our justice.* Living here and now, we know very well what the word *justice* means in the context of everyday life, but apart from this human justice, there is the Justice of God, inexhaustible and full of Love.

This is what we hear about in the second reading, from the Letter to the Thessalonians: *May the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, just as we have for you, so as to strengthen your hearts, to be blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his holy ones.* Why is love so important? Because God the Father gave the beginning to every creature as an expression of his love. Because He created man out of Love and – when he responded to God's love with sin – sent his Son into the world, again, out of Love. That is why only love can prepare us for the Second Coming, because only with love can we respond to love.

The words of today's Gospel, which speak about the signs in heaven and on earth at the end of times, call for a reflection. The entire created world will reach its end. Only man, created out of love, in God's image and likeness, will get a chance to survive the end. Man choosing God will receive a new life, man rejecting Him will perish, because only God brings salvation. God made the whole world as we know it and gave it to us; we get to know it through our senses, through science, through the constant search for answers to the questions that bother us. Today's Gospel serves as a warning against being caught up and swallowed up by fleeting earthly things. We must be prepared for this coming so that we can accept Christ not only as the Child in the Manger, but also as the One who, out of love, *chose us before the foundation of the world to be blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his holy ones.*
