REQUIREMENTS FOR PARENTS

- Complete Baptism Application form IN FULL** (*see attached*)
Children age 7 and older must go through a process called the *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* (RCIA) as preparation for Baptism. **For parents not registered at St. Peter Parish (or those registered for less than 6 months), there is an application fee of \$40.00 (due when completed application packet is submitted).** Parishioners who have been registered and actively involved for 6 months or longer are encouraged to give a donation.
- Letter of Permission to baptize from Pastor** (*only if you are not a member of St. Peter Parish*)
- Bring your child's birth certificate to the office, we need to see the original**

- Attend a Baptismal Prep Class** (*here at St. Peter or another Catholic parish*)
Attendance is *required* unless you have taken a class **within the past 4 months**. Classes are offered once per month in English here at St. Peter. Pre-registration and English comprehension are **required** to receive credit.

- Attend a Baptismal Prep Class** (*same conditions apply as for parents – see above*)
- Provide certified copies of sacramental records** (*annotated Baptism Certificate*)
