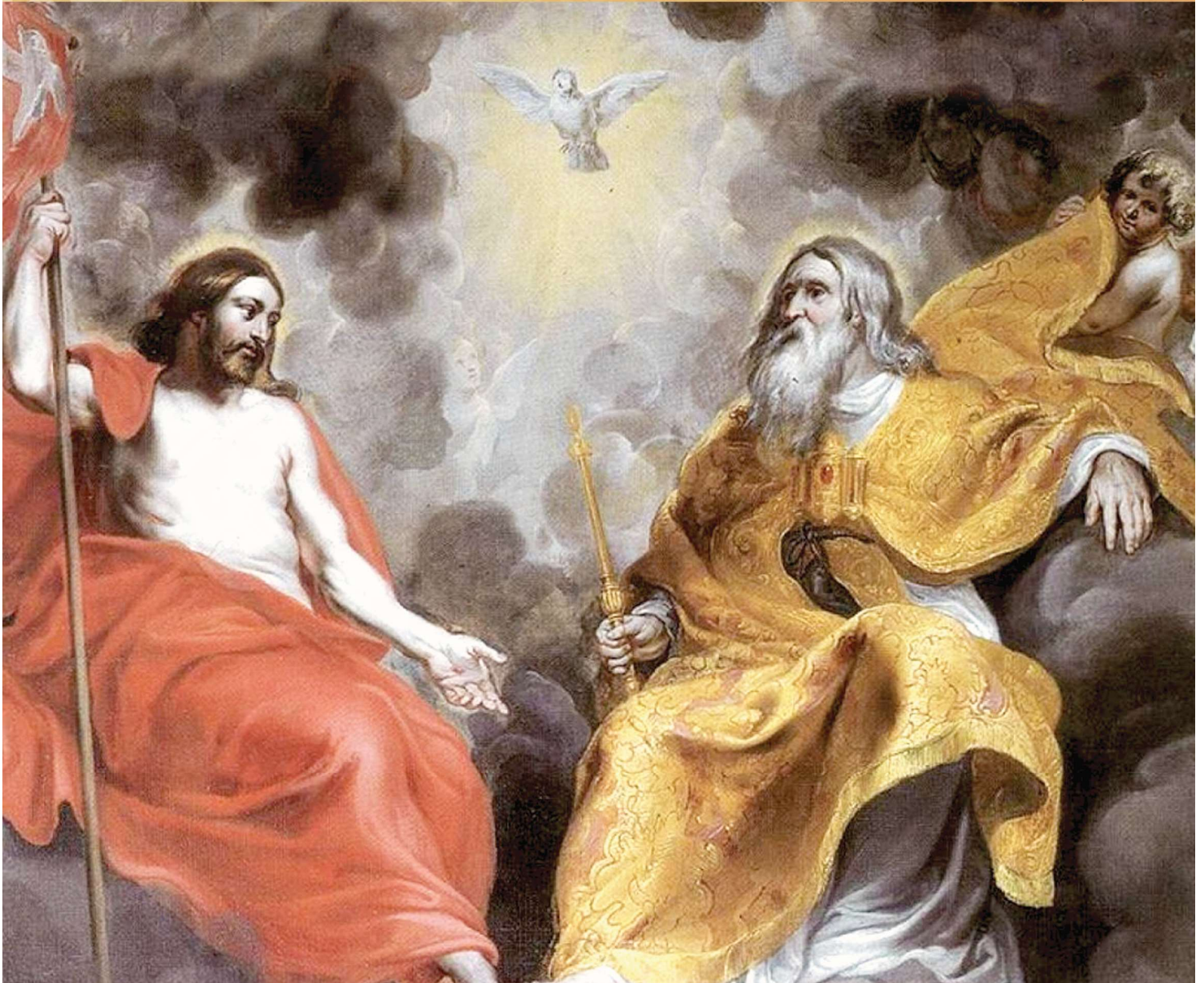

## Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

In the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit...  
I baptize you in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit...  
Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit...

Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, God, for ever and ever...

Constantly, often without realizing it, we profess our faith in the Holy Trinity. And we face a mystery. Many theologians have tried to present this mystery in a way more understandable to us. But it cannot be understood. We cannot comprehend how one God can exist in Three Persons. This does not mean, however, that we should not reflect on this truth of our faith. Let us try to consider it so that it becomes closer to us, so that we believe better.

How do we even know that there is one God and three Divine Persons? We believe this because God himself has revealed this truth. And not all right away. In fact, only the coming into the world of Jesus and the sending of the Holy Spirit gave us people the certainty of faith that the Holy Trinity really exists. However, it is in vain to look for the word "Trinity" in the Holy Scriptures. It is a word invented by us to describe the known but difficult, if not impossible to understand reality.

The mystery of the Holy Trinity is at the heart of the mystery of faith and of Christian life. Only God, in the act of revelation, can let us know himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit. In the Scriptures we can easily find places where three Divine Persons are mentioned. For example, at the Annunciation, the angel Gabriel clearly says that God sent him to announce to Mary that she would give birth to the Son of God, and that it would happen through the Holy Spirit. During Jesus' baptism in Jordan, the entire Holy Trinity is revealed: the Son of God stands on the shore, God the Father gives testimony to Him with His voice, and the Holy Spirit appears over Jesus in the form of a dove.

Faith in one God in Three Persons distinguishes Christianity from other religions. Beginning with our Baptism, we have been called to participate in the life of the Holy Trinity, here on earth, and after death in the eternal light. Through Baptism we were implanted into the life of the Holy Trinity. Although for our knowledge the life of the Holy Trinity is an impenetrable mystery, we were nevertheless included in this fullness of divine life: our soul was immersed in it.
