

Knowledge



- Striving to learn more about God through Scriptures (the bible) and through Church tradition
- Helps us to understand the meaning of what God has revealed, particularly in the Gospels
- See human beings and our talents for what they are: gifts from God.
 (we use our gifts to give glory to God)
- True self-knowledge (examination of conscience) helps us to choose the greater good and feel sorrow for choosing evil/sin



- See everyone and everything how might God see it. Looking at the bigger picture and God's plan of salvation not just our little moment of crisis
- Examine things going on in our lives from God's point of view and appreciate God working in our lives



Memory clue: i is an iceberg, an iceberg looks small on the surface of the water, but underneath it's much bigger.

- Finding the meaning of God's truths and their significance in our lives
- Helps us to recognize how God wants us to live
- Is more than stating the facts or memorizing facts, is really able to grasp the deeper meaning

Right Judgment (Counsel)




- Bridges the Intellectual and Practical Gifts
- Helps us make difficult decisions, especially when the answers are not obvious: choosing the right high school or college, career path, place to live, etc.
- Aids us with the words to say in a difficult situation
- Helps us to make choices that will lead us closer to God
- Helps us to know the difference between right and wrong



- Makes us aware of God's greatness, power and love and just how awesome He is
- Keeps us humble because He is God and we are NOT
- Fear of the Lord helps us to want to please Him



- Because we are aware of how GREAT God is, piety is our prayerful response
- Gives us a deep sense of respect for God and the Church
- Helps us approach God with humility, trust and love



- Helps us to face challenges and struggles with courage
- Helps us not to let life's obstacles pull us away from God
- Gives us a sense of God's presence
- Helps us persevere despite difficulty
 - "fight for holiness"
- Encourages us to tackle the world and overcome it!
