

Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

Every first Sunday of Lent brings us meditation on Jesus being led by the Holy Spirit into the wilderness, where He faces intense temptations from the devil. This episode not only reveals Christ's victory over sin and His total reliance on the Word of God, but it also serves as a powerful reminder that our journey of faith requires perseverance, trust, and active engagement with God's grace. Jesus resists the devil's offers with scriptural truth, modeling the importance of living out one's faith through obedience and steadfastness.

In the Letter to the Romans, St. Paul emphasizes the universality and simplicity of salvation: "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart." He proclaims that if we confess with our mouths that Jesus is Lord and believe in our hearts that God raised Him from the dead, we will be saved. This passage underscores the necessity of faith as the foundation of our justification. Yet, it is important to understand this faith not as mere intellectual assent, but as a living, transformative relationship with God.

From a Catholic perspective, justification involves both faith and works, a synthesis grounded in Scripture and Tradition. While St. Paul stresses the centrality of faith, the Letter of St. James complements this teaching by illuminating the dynamic nature of faith. In James 2:17, he famously states, "Faith without works is dead" . Here, St. James challenges us to consider the authenticity of our faith: if it does not manifest in acts of love, mercy, and justice, can it truly be alive?

Catholic theology views justification as a process rather than a one-time event. This process begins with God's grace, which enables us to believe and respond to His call. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church explains, "Justification includes the remission of sins, sanctification, and the renewal of the inner man" (CCC 2019). Faith is indispensable, but it is only through our cooperation with God's grace – expressed in good works – that faith is perfected and made visible.

Returning to Luke's Gospel, Jesus' resistance to temptation is a testament to His active commitment to the Father's will. Similarly, our faith must be demonstrated through tangible actions that reflect God's love and justice. In Romans, St. Paul reminds us that salvation is offered to all who believe, Jew and Gentile alike, uniting us in one body of Christ. This faith, however, calls us to a life of discipleship, where works of charity and obedience to God's commandments are integral.

In our own faith journey this Lent, let us consider how these passages call us to trust in Christ while embracing the transformative power of faith expressed through works. Let's reflect on how we can resist the "temptations of the wilderness" in our lives, standing firm in the Spirit; seek ways to make our faith visible through acts of kindness, service, and fidelity to the Gospel, knowing that it is through God's grace that we are empowered to love and act.

"The Sorrowful Mysteries help us relive the passion and death of Jesus. We not only remember it, but we also enter in - we keep watch with Jesus in his distress before his arrest (The Agony in the Garden). We enter into his suffering with The Scourging at the Pillar, The Crowning of Thorns, and The Carrying of the Cross ... and then we stand at the foot of that cross beside Mary as we witness his Crucifixion and Death. We attempt to understand the depths of God's love for us as we reflect on the cost of our salvation and redemption. We feel this sorrow and contrition even more deeply as we imagine it through the eyes of his mother.'

- 2. The Flight into Egypt
- 3. The Loss of Jesus in the Temple
- 4. Mary Meets Jesus on his Way to Calvary
- 5. Mary Stands at the Foot of the Cross
- 6. Jesus is Taken Down from the Cross
- 7. The Burial of Jesus

Feast: March 12



- Also known as Fina
- Young girl who lived in San Geminiano in Italy in the 1200s
- Her family was poor, but she always shared her food with others.
- Had diseases that left her paralyzed and laying on a board for 6 years in constant pain, was avoided because of her sores
- A few days before her death, she had a vision of St. Gregory the Great, who said that God would give her rest.
- When her body was removed from the plank, the rotten wood was covered with white violets.
- After she died, she grasped the arm of her best friend and healed her.
- Many miracles have come from St. Fina's intercession.
