18 Last Group

A godparent/sponsor is a Catholic who helps a candidate prepare for and receive the sacraments of baptism/confirmation. They act as a mentor and spiritual parent to the candidate, and are expected to be a strong Christian influence in their life. Godparents /Sponsors are responsible for helping the candidate live as a witness to Christ, and to fulfill the obligations of the sacrament. They also present the candidate to the bishop for anointing on the day of confirmation.

A Godparent/sponsor must be 16 years or older, not one of your parents, baptized & Confirmed Catholic, if married, married in the Catholic Church and going to Mass and confession regularly.
