WHAT IS A GODPARENT AND HOW DO I FIND ONE:

Godparents represent the Church and promise to help raise the child in the Catholic faith. You can have 2 godparents, one male and one female, they do not need to be married to each other. You cannot have 2 women or 2 men.

Spiritual Guidance:

They are expected to be examples of Catholic faith and to support the child's spiritual growth.

Ongoing Support:

Godparents should pray for their godchildren, offer guidance and support the child's faith for the rest of their life.

Not Legal Guardians:

Godparents do not automatically become legal guardians if the parents are unable to care for the child.

Godparent requirements

- godparent must be 16 years or older,
- not one of your parents
- baptized & Confirmed Catholic, if married, must be married in the Church,
- going to Mass and confession regularly.

REQUIRED PAPERWORK:

- Godparent eligibility form filled out by the godparent and signed by the pastor of the Catholic church where the sponsor attends Mass
- Copy of confirmation certificate
- Copy of Catholic marriage certificate (if married)
