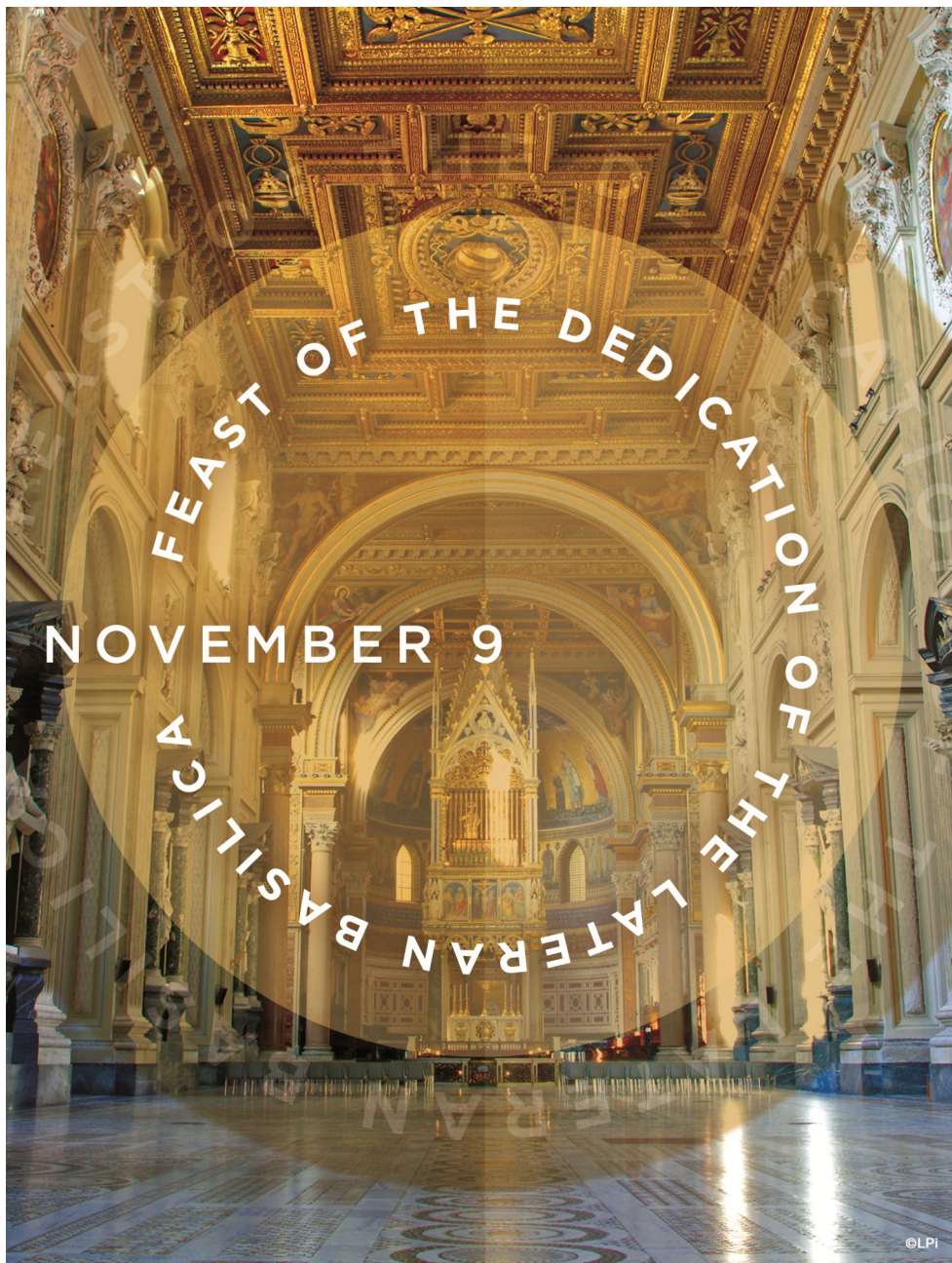

Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

Dogma vs Discipline

When Jesus enters the Temple and drives out the money changers, He isn't simply angry, He's consumed with love. *Zeal for your house will consume me*, the disciples recall. He sees the sacred being treated as ordinary, and He cannot remain silent. But then He says something even more shocking: "*Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.*" He's not speaking of the building. He's speaking of His Body. And through Him, we too become temples of the Holy Spirit. Paul says it plainly: *You are God's temple*. And Ezekiel's vision shows water flowing from the Temple, bringing life to everything it touches. That's the Church. That's the liturgy. That's the Eucharist. That's us.

But to live as the Church, we must understand the difference between dogma and discipline.

But to live as the Church, we must understand the difference between dogma and discipline. Dogma is the foundation, unchanging truths like the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Discipline is how we express those truths: the language of the Mass, how we receive Communion, or when bishops retire. These can change. The foundation cannot. This distinction helps us navigate questions that often arise.

So, why don't we always receive both the Body and Blood? Because Christ is fully present in either species. Offering both is a beautiful sign, but not a requirement. Should we receive Communion on the

hand or the tongue? Both are permitted. What matters is reverence. The discipline may vary, but the truth remains: we are receiving the living God. And why use Latin? Because it's the Church's universal language, a sign that the liturgy is not just local, but global. Even when we pray in English, Latin connects us to the saints and centuries. Why do bishops retire at 75, but not popes? Again, It's a pastoral discipline. Bishops step aside for the good of their dioceses. The pope, as Peter's successor, may resign, but is not required to.

Jesus is not asking whether we prefer one practice over another. He is asking whether we are consumed with zeal for the Father's house.

These are not trivial questions. But they must be held in the light of today's Gospel. Jesus is not asking whether we prefer one practice over another. He is asking whether we are consumed with zeal for the Father's house. The liturgy is not ours, it is God's. It is the river Ezekiel saw, flowing from the Temple, bringing life. It tells the story of salvation: we were created, captured by sin, redeemed by Christ, and now we respond. That's not a structure we invented; it's the shape of the cross. So let us not confuse the furniture with the foundation. Let us not turn the Temple into a marketplace of preferences. Let us be consumed with zeal, for truth, for reverence, for the One who raised the Temple in three days, and who now raises us to be His Body in the world.

Quick Facts

- Born in either 316 or 336 in what is now Hungary.
- Grew up in Northern Italy
- Became a Christian at age 10
- Served in the Roman military; at one point he encountered a beggar and gave him half of his cloak.
- Around age 20 he decided his faith no longer allowed him to serve in the military; he became the first conscientious objector in history.
- Left the military to study the faith under St. Hilary of Poitiers
- Helped his mother convert to Christianity
- Established a Benedictine monastery in France
- Unwillingly became Bishop of Tours, and worked hard to combat paganism
- Later retreated to become a monk
- Died in 397
- Many miracles have been attributed to him; one story says that he had a confrontation with the Devil
