### Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

### **Scripture and the Church**

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. But this King reigns not from a golden throne, but from the wood of the cross. In Luke's Gospel, we hear the voice of a dying thief: "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom." And Jesus replies, "Today you will be with me in paradise." This is the paradox of our faith: the crucified one is the King of glory.

Speaking of kings, our first reading recalls the anointing of David, when the tribes of Israel say, "We are your bone and your flesh." This echoes the Church's identity as the Body of Christ. From David's kingship to Christ's eternal reign, we see the unfolding of salvation history; a story carried forward by the Church, guided by the Holy Spirit.

The Church was born at Pentecost, but shaped over centuries. The Church Fathers defended the truth of Christ's divinity and humanity. The Ecumenical Councils, like Nicaea and Chalcedon, clarified the mystery of the Trinity and the Incarnation. These were not mere debates, they were acts of faith, led by the Spirit, to protect the flock from error.

St. Paul's letter to the Colossians proclaims that Christ is "the image of the invisible God," and "in Him all things hold together." This is the Christ revealed in Scripture, a canon discerned by the

Church, not invented. The 73 books of the Catholic Bible reflect the fullness of God's revelation, including the deuterocanonical texts that speak of resurrection, wisdom, and hope.

And how do we read Scripture? Not as science or fantasy, but as sacred story. Genesis is not a historical account or a tale of aliens or ancient technology, it is a poetic proclamation of God's creative love. The Church teaches us to read Scripture through its genres and senses: literal, allegorical, moral, and anagogical.

Finally, why did Jesus need to depart? He tells us, "It is better for you that I go, for if I do not go, the Advocate will not come" (John 16:7). His Ascension is not abandonment, it is exaltation. From heaven, He sends the Holy Spirit to animate the Church, to guide her into all truth, and to make us His witnesses.

So today, we do not merely admire Christ the King, we belong to Him. We are His bone and flesh, His Body and Bride. Let us live this story with faith, courage, and joy.







# **Ouick Facts** • Older brother of St. Peter

- One of the 12 Apostles
- Was a fisherman
- The Gospel of Matthew records Andrew and Peter being called by Jesus while fishing.
- The Gospel of John records Andrew as an apostle of John the Baptist before turning to follow Jesus.
- Was believed to have been one of Jesus' closer apostles.
- Told Jesus about the loaves and the fish for the feeding of the 5,000.
- Tradition says that Andrew was crucified on an X shaped cross because he felt unworthy to be crucified in the same way as Jesus.
- His relics and the cross on which he died are now at the Church of St. Andrew in Patras.
