

Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

Today we begin Advent, the start of our liturgical year and a season of preparation. The readings do not ease us in gently. They call us to wake up, to rise, to climb. Isaiah gives us a vision: the mountain of the Lord, rising above all others, drawing people from every nation. "Come," he says, "let us climb the Lord's mountain... that He may instruct us in His ways." This is not a passive image. It is a call to ascend, to leave behind the valleys of distraction and sin, and to seek the heights where God teaches and transforms. But climbing is not easy. It requires effort. It requires intention.

St. Paul echoes this urgency: "It is the hour now for you to awake from sleep... The night is advanced, the day is at hand." He urges us to cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light. And then he says: "Put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the desires of the flesh."

This is where we must confront a common phrase in our culture: "It's just natural to me." But our nature is wounded. Original sin has left its mark. We experience concupiscence, a pull toward selfishness, pride, and indulgence. What comes naturally is not always what leads to life. The Gospel calls us not to what is natural, but to what is supernatural.

And Jesus, in today's Gospel, warns us: "As it was in the days of Noah... they were eating and drinking... and they did not know until the flood came." They were living what they called "natural" lives, but they were unprepared. "Therefore," Jesus says, "stay awake! For you do not know on which day your Lord will come." Following Christ is not natural. It is intentional.

Advent is our wake-up call. It is the season to form our intentions. To climb. To choose the spirit over the flesh. To live not by instinct, but by grace. Let us begin this new liturgical year with resolve. Let us ascend the mountain of the Lord, where He will teach us His ways and we will walk in His paths. Let us live not by what is easy, but by what is holy.


