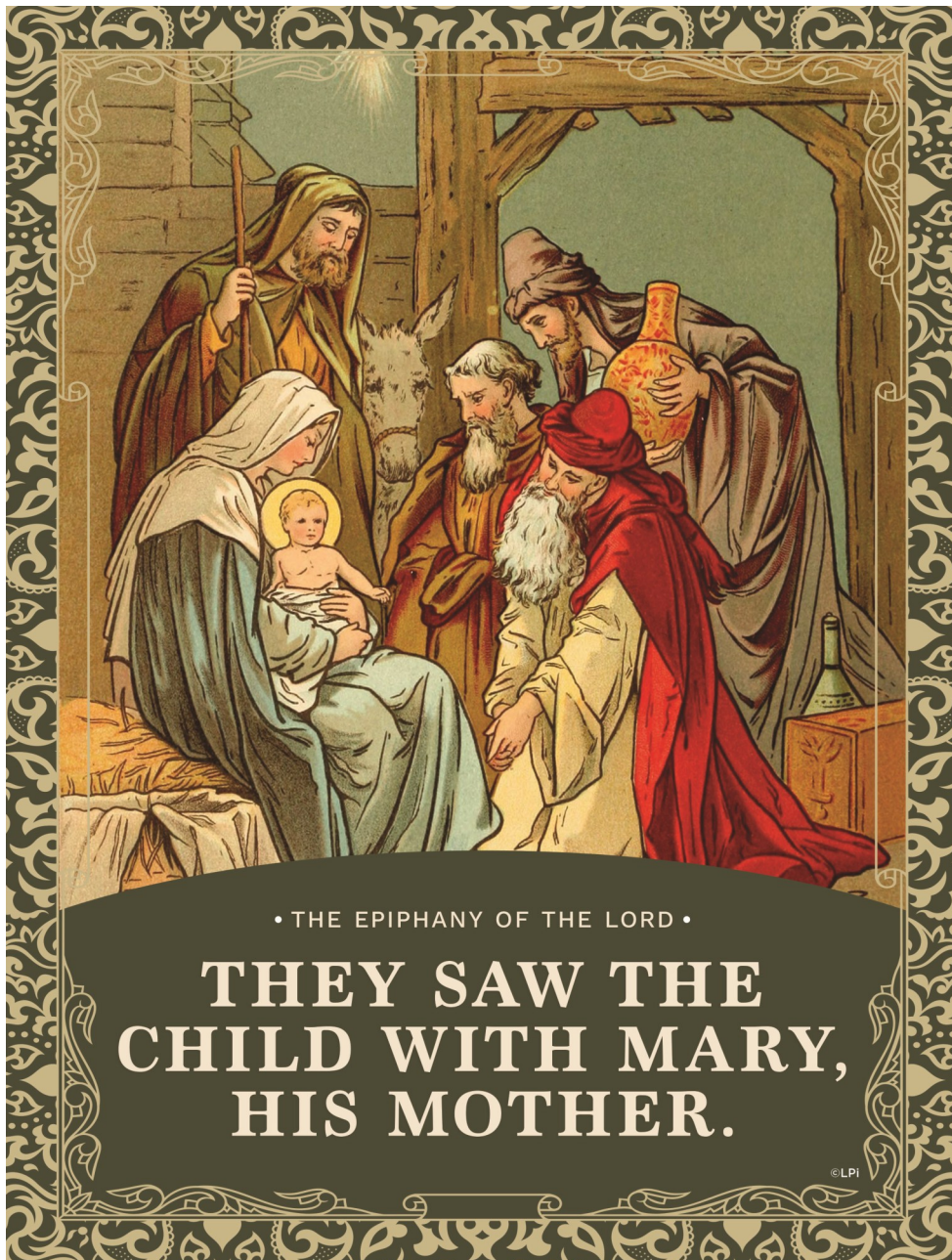

## Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

Today we celebrate the Epiphany, the manifestation of Christ to the nations. The Gospel of Matthew tells us of the Magi, wise men from afar, who followed the star to adore the newborn King. They represent all peoples drawn to Christ. Their journey is our journey, for in them we see ourselves approaching God with longing hearts.

Isaiah proclaims: *"Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord rises upon you."* Nations stream toward this light, bringing gifts and treasures. This vision is fulfilled in Jesus, the true Light who has come into the world. His birth is not for one people alone, but for the salvation of all humanity. In Christ, God's desire is revealed: that every person, from every nation, be gathered into His family.

Saint Paul makes this mystery clear in Ephesians: *"The Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus."* What was hidden is now revealed, God's plan is universal. No one is excluded from His mercy. The Epiphany celebrates this boundless generosity: God's love is for all.

The Magi show us how to respond. They did not come empty-handed. They brought gold, frankincense, and myrrh, the best they had. Their gifts symbolize honor, worship, and thanksgiving. They recognized in the Child the goodness of God, and they offered what was most precious in return. In them, we see our own call: to bring before the Lord the best of ourselves: our talents, our time, our love. Not because God needs our gifts, but because gratitude demands a response.

We may not carry gold or incense, but we carry our lives. We bring our joys and sorrows, our strengths and weaknesses, our hopes and fears. When we place them before Christ, He receives them with love and transforms them. In thanksgiving for His generosity, we offer ourselves back to Him. God desires the whole of humanity to be saved. Let us walk with the Magi, guided by the light of Christ, and offer Him the best of who we are. In doing so, we become living witnesses of His goodness, shining His light into the world.

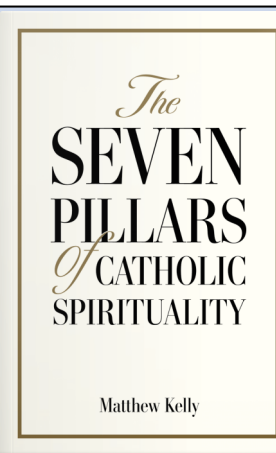
### Why 40 Hours?

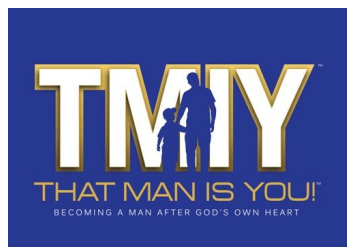

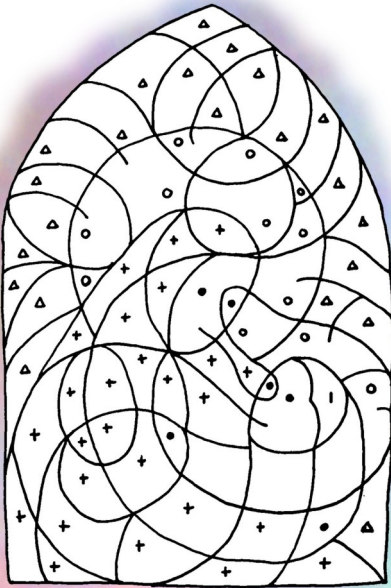

## Corporal Works of Mercy (Last Week) Spiritual Works of Mercy

The Spiritual Works of Mercy have long been a part of the Christian tradition, appearing in the works of theologians and spiritual writers throughout history. Just as Jesus attended to the spiritual well-being of those he ministered to, these Spiritual Works of Mercy guide us to "help our neighbor in their spiritual needs" (United States Catholic Catechism for Adults) (source: usccb.org)

### 1. Counsel the Doubtful

- Be at witness to Christ in everything you say and do.
- Talk to a friend or family member who is struggling with their faith. It's okay if you don't know all the answers. There are many resources to help you find them!

### 2. Instruct the Ignorant

- Go on a mission trip to help spread the Gospel to other parts of the world
- Invite someone to go to Mass with you.
- Help out with a religious education program at your parish.

### 3. Admonish the Sinner

- Don't be judgmental, but guide others toward right living, and don't show support for other people's sins.
- Lovingly correct others, while also remembering that you are a sinner, too.

### 4. Comfort the Sorrowful

- Listen and spend time with those having a hard time.
- Send a card or a note to someone who is struggling.
- Pray for those who are suffering.

### 5. Forgive Injuries

- Let go of grudges; refusing to forgive someone hurts you more than them.
- Apologize for wrongs you have committed.
- Pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet
- Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation

### 6. Bear Wrongs Patiently

- Don't let resentment take hold of your heart.
- Pray and ask God for patience when you have been wronged.

### 7. Pray for the Living and the Dead

- Have a Mass said for someone living or deceased.
- Ask family and friends for prayer requests.
- Keep your own list of people to pray for, both living and dead.

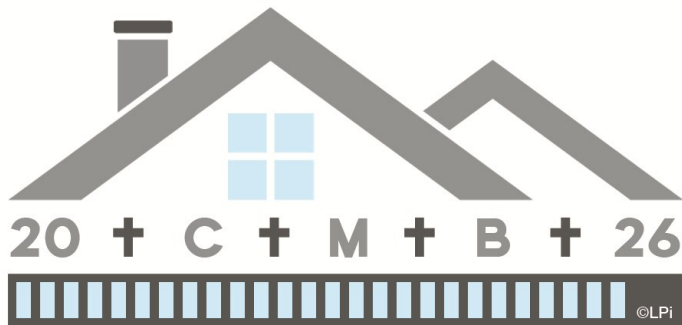
