

Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

“Behold the Lamb of God.” John the Baptist speaks these words with a clarity that shakes the air around him. He knows exactly who stands before him. Not another rabbi. Not another moral teacher. Not another prophet. But God, God in the flesh, walking toward him. And yet, just a few verses earlier, John says something haunting: “Among you stands one whom you do not know.” He is already in their midst. Already present. Already near. But they do not recognize Him. That line is not only about first-century Judea. It is about us.

Somewhere along the way, we too can lose awareness of the One who stands among us. We can walk into church as if it were just another building. We can pass the tabernacle without a glance. We can hear the Gospel as if it were merely advice. We can receive the Eucharist as if it were routine. Not because we reject God, but because we forget God is truly here. Our lack of reverence often begins with a lack of awareness.

Isaiah reminds us that the One who comes is not merely a servant of God but the One through whom God reveals His glory: “It is too little... to raise up the tribes of Jacob; I will make you a light to the nations.” Only God can bear that mission. Only God can fulfill it. And that God has stepped into our world and now dwells sacramentally in our midst.

Paul tells the Corinthians they are “sanctified in Christ Jesus.” Not inspired. Not instructed. Sanctified, made holy, because the One who touches them is Holiness Himself. Christ is not simply a moral authority who interprets natural law; He is the Logos through whom natural law exists. He does not merely speak God’s message; He is God’s message. If this is true, and it is, then our posture before Him matters.

The early disciples approached Jesus with awe because they understood who stood before them. They bowed, they listened, they followed with hearts awake. Their reverence flowed from recognition. And perhaps that is where we must begin again: with recognition. To remember that “among us stands One whom we do not know”, or rather, One we have forgotten to notice. To let the truth of His presence awaken our awe. To walk into this church aware that the God who created galaxies dwells here. To genuflect not out of habit but out of love. To listen to the Gospel as if God Himself is speaking, because He is. To receive the Eucharist with the wonder of someone who knows they are touching the living God.

Reverence is not stiffness. It is awareness. Awe is not fear. It is love awakened. John points and says, “Behold.” The Church echoes him at every Mass. The question is whether we still recognize the One who stands among us. May the Lord restore in us the awareness that leads to awe, the awe that leads to reverence, and the reverence that leads to joy. For the message is not an idea. The message is a Person. And that Person is here.

THE TAKE-AWAYS

- Even though the eternal punishment of hell is wiped away when we go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, there is still a temporal (earthly) punishment for our sins.
- The temporal punishment for our sins is met in purgatory.
- An indulgence takes away some or all of the temporal punishment that we would experience in purgatory..
- A plenary indulgence erases all temporal punishment, while a partial indulgence erases some of it.
- You can apply an indulgence for yourself or for souls in purgatory.
- You can obtain one plenary indulgence per day.
- There are a few conditions which must be met for a plenary indulgence:

1. Receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation within 20 days of the indulgence. Complete detachment from all sin, including venial sin, is necessary for the indulgence to be plenary.
2. Receive Holy Communion on the day you perform the indulgence.
3. Pray for the intentions of the Holy Father (usually an Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be.)
4. Perform an indulged work: Make a pilgrimage to a church or holy site; pray a rosary, participate in Stations of the Cross, read the Bible for at least 30 minutes; or perform a work of charity for another.

FOR DEEPER CONTEMPLATION

"An indulgence is obtained through the Church who, by virtue of the power of binding and loosing granted her by Christ Jesus, intervenes in favor of individual Christians and opens for them the treasury of the merits of Christ and the saints to obtain from the Father of mercies the remission of the temporal punishments due for their sins. Thus the Church does not want simply to come to the aid of these Christians, but also to spur them to works of devotion, penance, and charity." (CCC 1478)

Patron of Catholic writers, the Catholic press, the deaf, journalists, adult education

Quick Facts

- Born in Switzerland in 1567
- Wanted to become a priest, but his father wanted him to become a lawyer
- One day while horseback riding, he fell from his horse 3 times. Each time his sword came out of its scabbard and both fell to the ground in the shape of a cross.
- After disagreements with his father, he finally became a priest in 1593.
- Worked for 3 years to try to bring Calvinists back to the Catholic Church. He slipped pamphlets under doors and also evangelized to people through their children.
- Became friends with Jane de Chantal.
- Emphasized that everyone is called to holiness and anyone can achieve sainthood, including lay people
- Wrote *Introduction to the Devout Life*, which was written for lay people to guide them in their pursuit of holiness.
- Was often ill because of overwork due to his popularity, died in 1622.
- Is a Doctor of the Church
