

Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

There is a phrase we hear often today when we speak honestly about sin: *"Jesus would just love me."* The implication is that correction is unloving, that naming sin is judgment, and that the Christian who speaks truth is somehow failing to imitate Christ. But the readings today dismantle that misunderstanding. They show us that admonishing the sinner is not the opposite of love, it is one of its deepest expressions. And Jesus Himself does exactly that in the Gospel.

Sirach begins with a striking reminder: *"If you choose, you can keep the commandments... Before man are life and death, good and evil."* God respects our freedom, but He also tells us plainly that our choices have consequences. This is not cruelty, it is love. A parent who warns a child about fire is not being harsh. A doctor who tells a patient the truth about their illness is not being unkind. Love speaks truth because love desires life.

Saint Paul, in the second reading, reminds us that God's wisdom is not the world's wisdom. The world says: *"Affirm me, approve me, never challenge me."* But God's wisdom says: *"Come into the light, so that you may be healed."* The world equates love with permissiveness. God equates love with salvation. And salvation requires conversion.

Then Jesus, in the Gospel, takes this even further. He does not soften the law; He intensifies it. He does not say, *"Do whatever you feel."* He says, *"You have heard it said... but I say to you."* He goes to the heart. Anger, lust, dishonesty, He names them all. He exposes the roots of sin because He wants to free us from the whole tree. This is not the Jesus of sentimental imagination. This is the Jesus who loves us enough to confront us. He does not condemn the sinner, but He absolutely condemns the sin that destroys the sinner. And He calls us to do the same.

It is true that obedience to the law does not save us. Only grace does. But disobedience to the law can condemn us, because it is a rejection of the God who gave the law. The commandments are not arbitrary rules, they are the shape of a life that leads to God. To break them knowingly and willingly is to walk away from the One who loves us.

FASTING


Catholics in good health ages 18 to 59 are required to fast and to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

An Examination of Conscience

1st Commandment: I am the Lord your God. You shall not have strange gods before me.

- Do I give God time every day in prayer? Do I seek to love Him with my whole heart?
- Have I been involved with superstitious practices (horoscopes or Ouija boards) or have I been involved with the occult?
- Do I seek to surrender myself to God's Word as taught by the Church?
- Have I received Communion in the state of mortal sin?
- Have I deliberately told a lie in Confession or withheld a mortal sin from the priest?

2nd Commandment: You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.

- Have I used God's name in vain?
- Have I been angry with God?
- Have I insulted a sacred person or abused a sacred object?
- Have I wished evil upon another person?

3rd Commandment: Remember to keep holy the Lord's Day.

- Have I deliberately missed Mass on Sundays or Holy Days of Obligation? Have I kept Sunday as a family day and a day of rest? Do I do needless work on Sundays or make others work on Sundays?

4th Commandment: Honor your father and mother.

- Do I honor and obey my parents? Do I respect my elders? Do I respect my pastor, bishop, and the Pope?
- Have I neglected my duties to my spouse or children?
- Have I given my family a good religious example? Do I try to bring peace into my home life?

Next Archbishop of Denver Announced

On Saturday, February 7th, Pope Leo XIV accepted the resignation of Archbishop Samuel Aquila and appointed Bishop James Golka, currently Bishop of

Colorado Springs, to succeed him.

Bishop Golka is from Grand Island, Nebraska, one of 10 children. He has degrees in Philosophy, Theology, and Sacramental Theology. He also is fluent in Spanish and has a heart for the Hispanic community.

At the press conference last Saturday after the announcement was made, Bishop Golka said, "I want to be faithful to Jesus. I want to be faithful to his Church. I'm going to be thankful for his teachings. I want to be grateful to where the Spirit is leading us." (Denver Catholic)

Bishop Golka will be officially installed as Archbishop of Denver on March 25, the Feast of the Annunciation.
