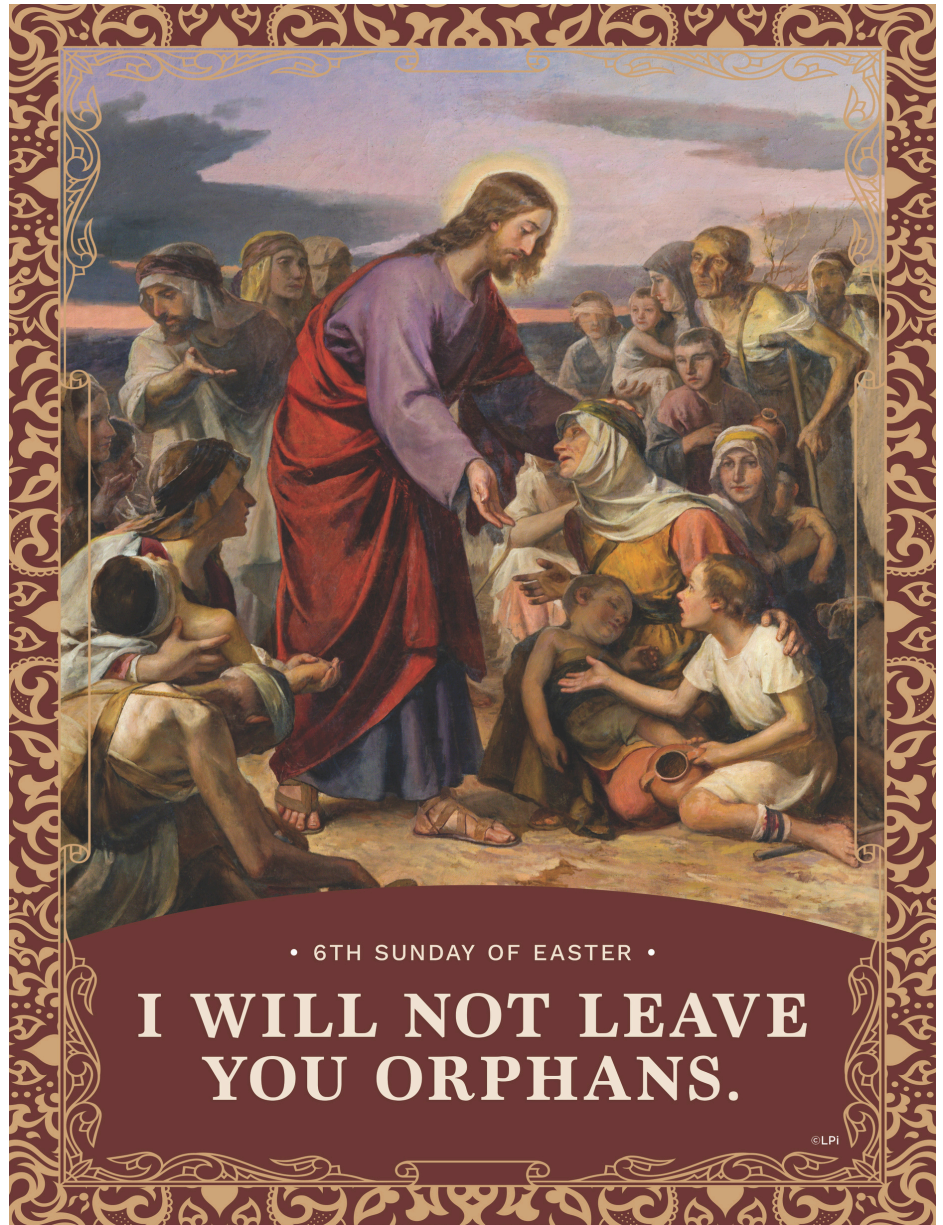

Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

As we approach the Ascension and Pentecost, the Church places before us a simple but searching invitation: to loosen our grip on what is temporary, so that God may fill us with what endures forever.

In the Gospel today, Jesus tells His disciples, "I will not leave you orphans." He promises the Advocate, the Spirit of truth, who will remain with them. That word remain is the key. Everything of this world eventually passes. Our comforts, our fears, our plans, our reputations, even our strength and our youth; all of it belongs to the realm of the temporary. But the Spirit belongs to the realm of the eternal. The Spirit is God's own life poured into us, a life that does not fade.

We see this in the first reading. The Samaritans hear the preaching of Philip and receive the word with joy. But it is only when Peter and John lay hands on them that they receive the Holy Spirit. They let go of their former ways, and God fills the empty space with something that lasts. The early Church grows not because people cling to what is familiar, but because they allow God to replace the temporary with the eternal.

And Saint Peter, in the second reading, urges us to "sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts." That is not a call to cling more tightly to earthly security. It is a call to anchor ourselves in the One who cannot be shaken. Peter knows suffering and misunderstanding are real. But he also knows they do not have the final word. They are temporary. Christ is eternal.

Scripture often contrasts "flesh" and "spirit." It is not a rejection of the body. It is a reminder that some things pass away, and some things endure. The flesh is whatever we cling to that cannot last: resentment, fear, control, sin, the need to be admired, the need to be right. The Spirit is what God gives that cannot die: love, mercy, courage, fidelity, hope.

And so the Lord asks each of us today: What temporary thing are you holding onto that is keeping you from receiving what is eternal? Letting go is not loss. Letting go is making room. When we release what is temporary, the Spirit fills the space with what endures. May our relationship with God strengthen us to let go of what fades, so that we may receive the life that remains forever.

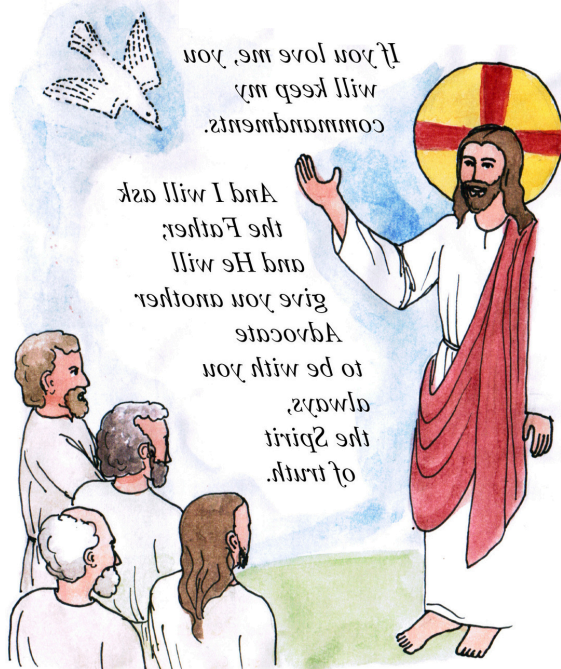

When the apostles in Jerusalem heard that SAMARIA had accepted the WORD of GOD, they sent PETER and JOHN to them, and they went DOWN there, and PRAYED for the Samaritans to receive the HOLY SPIRIT, for as yet he had not COME down on any of them: they had only been baptised in the NAME of the Lord Jesus. The Nicene Creed part 9

“He will come again in glory”

- “[Jesus] came once to earth (taking to himself a human nature), brought that nature glorified to heaven, and then will come again in order to glorify all of matter, all of space, and all of time.”
- “The ascended Jesus, who is God and man, finally draw[s] all things to himself, so that earth and heaven meet in a marvelous conubium (marriage)...a coming together of the two dimensions in a kind of embrace.”
- Many texts of the New Testament talk about the second coming of Jesus at the end of time.
- “The ‘coming again’ of Jesus...involves the elevation and glorification of the whole of God’s creation.”
- We don’t know exactly what this new heaven and new earth will be like, but we can say, based on the resurrected Jesus, that “the new state of affairs will be, in a way, the same earth and the same heavens, but now lifted up to a condition of perfection.”

“To judge the living and the dead”

- “We should see that this divine discrimination [the judgment of God] should be, in fact, a source of vindication and comfort rather than dread.”
- All we have to do is look at the world to see that it is a “dark, violent, and deeply unjust place.” “By an altogether legitimate instinct, we say that all of these injustices ‘cry out to heaven for vengeance.’ Knowing full well that nothing here below can truly right these wrongs, and knowing furthermore that there is an objective standard for all of our moral judgments, we refer these sins to God...we can hope that all sins, even those lost in the mists of history, can be addressed, and all suffering, even of people long dead, can be soothed.”

“And his kingdom will have no end”

- “The entire drama of nature and history, which would have unfolded over eons of time, will come, finally, to an end, but not a dead end, not to a condition of stasis, but rather to ‘rest’-- which is to say, a savoring of the supreme good.
- “[History] is moving, under the direction of the Holy Spirit, toward a fulfillment beyond what any philosopher or seer could imagine: the kingdom without end.”
