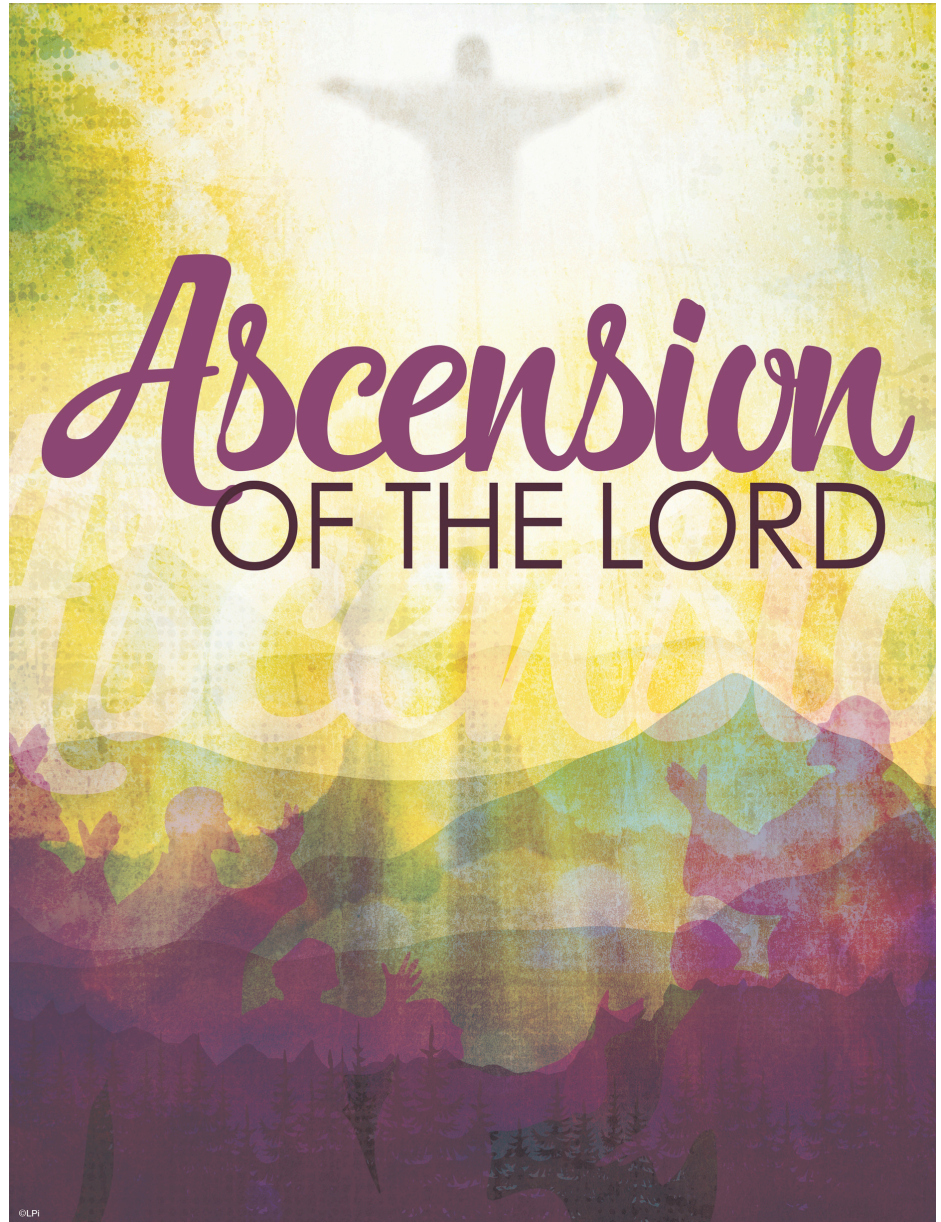

## Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

The Ascension of the Lord is not the story of Christ leaving us. It is the moment He takes His place as Lord of all creation and entrusts His universal mission to His Body, the Church. And in that mission, we discover what it truly means that the Church is Catholic: universal, throughout the whole, for all.

In the first reading from Acts, Jesus tells the apostles, "You will be my witnesses... to the ends of the earth." This is the first note of Catholicity. The Gospel is not meant for one people or one land. It is not a local tradition or a private spirituality. From the beginning, Christ sends His Church outward, across borders, cultures, and languages. The Church is Catholic because her mission is geographically universal. No nation is outside the reach of Christ's love. No people are excluded from His salvation.

But the second reading from Ephesians widens the horizon even further. Paul tells us that Christ is seated "far above every principality and power," and that God has placed all things beneath His feet. Christ's Ascension reveals a universality that is not only global but cosmic. His reign extends beyond geography, beyond time, beyond the visible world. And Paul adds that Christ is given as head over all things to the Church, which is His Body.

This means the Church's Catholicity is not merely about reaching every corner of the earth. It is about participating in the universal lordship of Christ, a mission that touches heaven and earth, the living and the dead, the visible and the invisible. The Church is Catholic because her mission is cosmically universal.

Then, in the Gospel, Jesus gives the Great Commission: "Go... make disciples of all nations." This is the Church's charter. To be Catholic is to be missionary. To be Catholic is to be outward-facing. To be Catholic is to carry the Gospel to every human heart. The Church is Catholic because her mission is personally universal, directed to every person without exception.

And Scripture even gives us the moment the Church receives her name. Acts 9:31 describes "the Church throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria." The Greek phrase ἡ ἐκκλησία καθ' ὅλης literally means "the Church throughout the whole." From this expression comes the word Catholic. Already in the apostolic age, the Church understood herself as one Body spread throughout the whole world, united in faith and mission. May we live this Catholic mission with courage, joy, and hope.

## The Nicene Creed part 10

### "I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life"

- The Nicene Creed "is essentially Trinitarian in structure and purpose."
- "The Holy Spirit is definitely a 'who' rather than a 'what,' despite the rather impersonal descriptor. The reason is that the Creed immediately refers to the Spirit as 'Lord.' This personalizes him, of course, and also links the Holy Spirit to the Son of God, whom the Creed calls the 'Lord Jesus Christ;' and in one deft move, it unambiguously affirms the deity of the Spirit, for 'Lord' is a term used, again and again, of the God of Israel."
- "The Creed gives us another crucially important indicator when it speaks of the Spirit as zoopoion (giver of life)...All the vitality that came forth from the Creator issued from this ultimate source of life...the Spirit is a divine source of life in multiple senses of the term: physical, moral, intellectual, and corporate."
- The Gospels speak of the influence of the Holy Spirit on the ministry of Jesus: in his conception, his baptism, and at his resurrection.
- "In the aftermath of Pentecost, the Spirit is unleashed upon the world. He guides, bears witness, prays, teaches, speaks, converts, lifts up, inspires, and directs." He is the "principal actor in the life of the early Church."

### "Who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified"

- "The shared love between Father and Son...is the Spiritus Sanctus, the Holy Breath...the love proceeding from the Father and the Son is fully divine. He therefore should not be construed along the lines of an act of the will that is but an expression of an underlying consciousness. It is not one thing that God happens to do, but rather God himself."
- "The purpose of [Jesus's] mission is none other than the gathering of the human race into the Trinitarian life...the capacity to love in the utterly disinterested way that the Trinity loves."
- We imperfectly refer to the Trinity as "persons," but they are not separate entities. "The Father is Father only in and as a relation to the Son; the Son is Son only in and as a relation to the Father; and the Spirit is Spirit only in and as a relation to the Father and the Son."
- "The Holy Spirit works in tight connection with Jesus, and...the truth implicit in the teaching of Jesus requires the ministrations of the Spirit to come to fully developed expression...The Spirit...is the Interpreter of the Word..."
