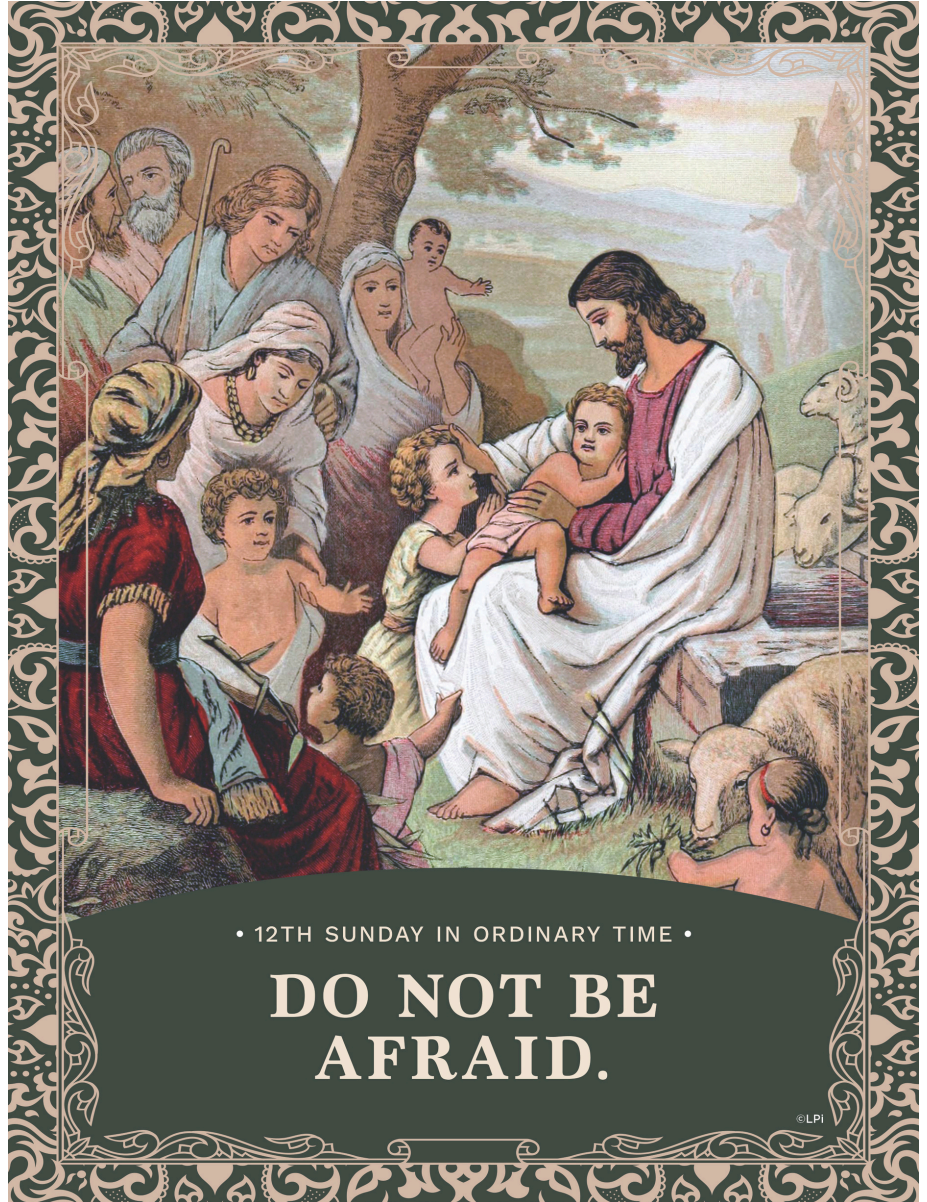

## Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

The readings today place us beside the prophet Jeremiah, a man who knew what it meant to be misunderstood, accused, and surrounded by voices that wished him harm. He speaks of hearing “terror on every side” and of friends waiting for him to stumble. Yet Jeremiah does not collapse under the weight of their words. He does not let bitterness take root. Instead, he anchors himself in one truth: “The Lord is with me, like a mighty champion.” His vindication is not in winning arguments or proving others wrong, but in trusting that God sees, God knows, and God will act.

Jesus, in the Gospel, tells the disciples not to fear those who can wound the body or damage reputation. He reminds them that the Father sees even the smallest sparrow fall. If God notices something so small, how much more does He notice the quiet suffering of His children who remain faithful when it would be easier to lash out or give up.

This is where the challenge lies for us. People will annoy us. People will misunderstand us. Sometimes we will be accused of things we did not do. Sometimes our efforts will be ignored, our sacrifices unseen, our intentions doubted. And the temptation is always the same: to defend ourselves endlessly, to hold on to resentment, or to stop doing good because it feels unappreciated.

But the readings call us to a different freedom. The freedom to let go. The freedom to continue serving God even when no one notices. The freedom to do what is right without demanding a reward. The freedom to entrust our reputation, our vindication, and our peace to the Lord.

This is our strength. It is the strength of Jeremiah. It is the strength of Christ, who continued His mission even when surrounded by hostility. It is the strength of every disciple who knows that the only reward worth having is the knowledge that we are doing the will of God.

So today, ask the Lord for this grace: the grace to release the small injuries, to surrender the unjust accusations, and to keep walking in fidelity. Let your peace come not from how others treat you, but from the quiet certainty that God sees your heart and delights in your faithfulness.

If that is our reward, it is more than enough.

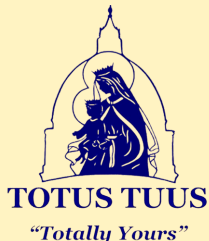

## The Our Father part 1

The Lord's Prayer (also known as the Our Father) is not just one Christian prayer among many. It is the prayer Jesus revealed to the apostles when they asked him, "Lord, teach us to pray" (Luke 11:1). The Catechism describes the Lord's Prayer as not only "the most perfect of prayers" (CCC 2763) but as "the summary of the whole Gospel" (CCC 2761, quoting Tertullian). This is why the Lord's Prayer is an integral part of the Sacraments initiation, the weekly celebration of the Eucharist, and the major hours of prayer in the Divine Office. In this one short prayer, we find encapsulated the story of salvation and the supreme model for all Christian prayer.

The Our Father consists of seven petitions. Like the Ten Commandments, the petitions in the Lord's Prayer can be divided into two parts, with the first three focused on God himself and the next four involving our human needs. In the first three petitions, the Lord's Prayer leads us toward God for his own sake. Before we bring our personal needs to the Lord, we pray for his name to be hallowed, his Kingdom to come, and his will to be done. As CCC 2804 explains, "It is characteristic of love to think first of the one whom we love:"

Jesus Himself gave us this prayer as the model of all prayer. It is good that we repeat the words of the Lord's Prayer regularly in vocal prayer. This is also done in the various sacraments and liturgical worship. However, saying this prayer is not enough. The goal is to internalize each and every aspect of this prayer so that it becomes a model of our personal petition to God and an entrustment of our entire life to Him.

*Our Father who art in heaven,  
hallowed be thy name.  
Thy kingdom come.  
Thy will be done  
on earth, as it is in heaven.  
Give us this day our daily bread,  
and forgive us our trespasses,  
as we forgive those who trespass against us,  
and lead us not into temptation,  
but deliver us from evil.

## Stewardship Corner

Jesus minces no words with his disciples: If we acknowledge Jesus publicly, Jesus will remember us before God, our Father. If we deny Jesus, he will forget us. It is very rare that a Christian will denounce Jesus publicly. But we can deny Jesus in more subtle ways. There are many people who conveniently forget all about Jesus Christ and the work of his Kingdom in their daily lives, in moments of weakness, spiritual immaturity or when times get tough. Good stewards strengthen their confession of Christ by praying and attending Mass regularly, examining their lives and going to confession frequently, and reminding themselves daily that Christ resides in them. Take a look at your own daily life. Do you acknowledge Christ before others? How often do you remind yourself that Jesus lives in you?

## Blessing of Fathers



God and Father of all creation, we come before you today with humble hearts. You are our model of a loving father. When we fail and fall short of your expectations, you are always there at the end of the day with open arms, ready to heal the cuts and scrapes of the day and to encourage us to try again and not to give up.

We hold up these men in our midst who act in the world as fathers to their children or models of fathers for others.

Bless them in their moments of doubt and frustration with their children. Give them warm and open hearts to forgive failures. Provide them with the words needed for encouragement and perseverance. We ask all this in the name of Jesus. Amen.
