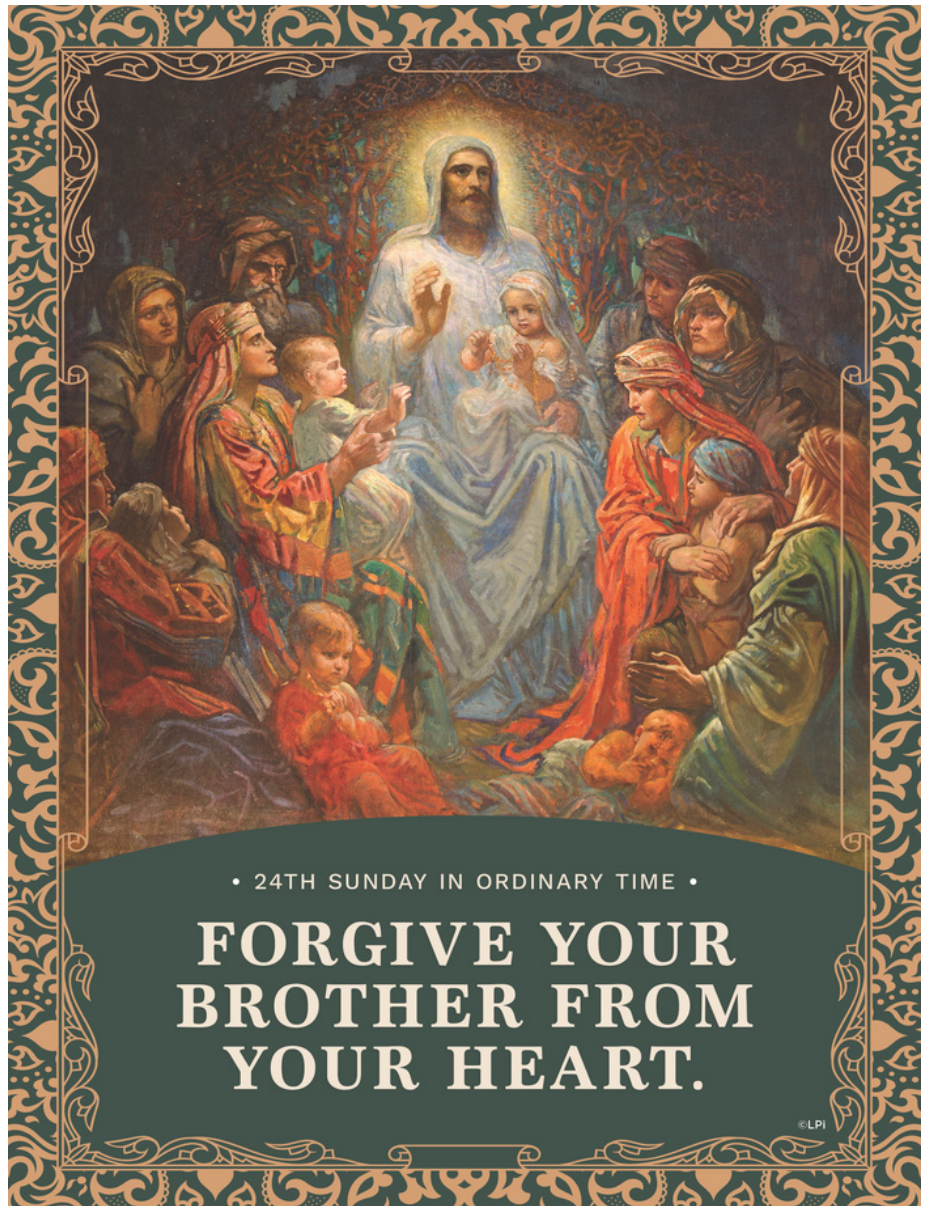

Fr. Tomasz's Weekly Reflection

In the readings today we find reference the description of what can be defined as God's anger and wrath. Scripture uses these words, but not to describe a God who lashes out. Rather, it reveals what happens when we turn away from the path of life. God's wrath is not something He does to us; it is the spiritual consequence of our own choices, especially the choice to refuse forgiveness.

In the first reading, Ezekiel is appointed as a watchman. His task is not to threaten punishment but to warn Israel of the danger that comes from ignoring God's ways. Sin carries its own weight. When we cling to resentment, bitterness, or the desire to hold something over another person, we are not punished by God, we are simply closing the very door through which His mercy wants to enter.

Jesus makes this painfully clear in the Gospel. He speaks about reconciliation within the community, urging us to seek healing, to speak truth with charity, and to restore communion. But He also warns that if we refuse to forgive, we place ourselves outside the flow of grace. Not because God withdraws His mercy, but because unforgiveness makes us incapable of receiving what He is always offering.

Think of it this way: mercy is like sunlight. It shines constantly. But if I shut myself inside a windowless room, the darkness I experience is not caused by the sun's absence, but rather it is caused by my refusal to open the door. Unforgiveness is that closed room. It traps us in a spiritual climate where grace cannot penetrate, not because God is unwilling, but because we are unyielding.

Saint Paul reminds us in the second reading that "None of us lives for oneself". We are a part of the system that God has established, and when we separate ourselves from one another by unforgiveness, we separate ourselves from God as well. Wrath, in the biblical sense, is what happens when we choose against God, when we cling to what wounds us instead of releasing it to God.

Forgiveness does not mean pretending the hurt never happened. It means refusing to let the hurt define our future. It means choosing freedom over captivity. And when we forgive, we do not only open the door for the other person, we open it for ourselves. We allow God's mercy to reach us again.

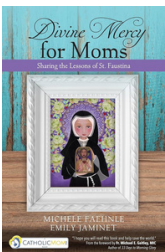

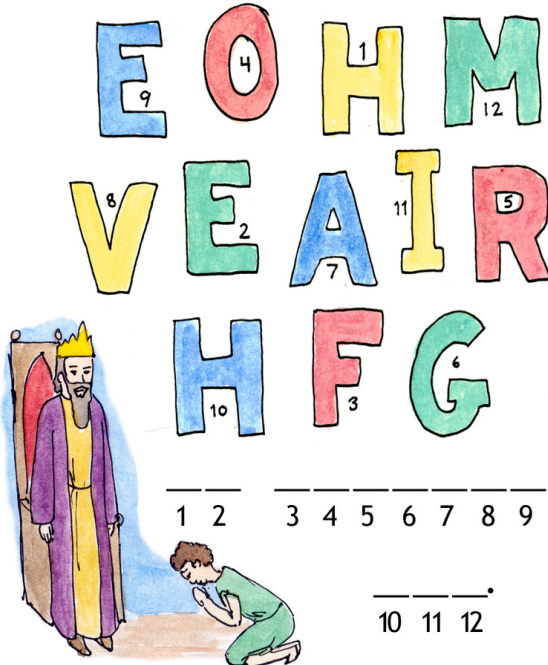

"The Hail Holy Queen prayer, originally known by its Latin name, Salve Regina, is recited at the end of the Rosary and is also used in night prayers. It dates back to around the 11th century and is still sung today as a hymn in various forms, among them a beautiful chant.

St. Alphonsus Liguori thought so highly of the Hail Holy Queen that he analyzed it in great detail in his well-known 18th century book The Glories of Mary. In this prayer we pay homage to the Blessed Virgin Mary, our "Mother of Mercy," and humbly ask for her assistance. Many religious over the centuries (including quite a few saints!) have considered her help to be essential for our salvation."

*Hail Holy Queen, Mother of mercy,
Our life, our sweetness, and our hope.
To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve.
To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and
weeping in this valley of tears.
Turn then, most gracious advocate,

"I may be allowed to make a short digression and give my own sentiment here. I would say that when an opinion tends in any way to the honor of the Most Blessed Virgin Mary, when it has some foundation and is not repugnant to the Faith, nor to the decrees of the Church, nor to truth, to refuse to hold it, or to oppose it because the reverse may be true, shows little devotion to the Mother of God.

"I do not choose to be counted in that company, nor do I wish my reader to be. I wish rather to be in the company of those who fully and firmly believe all that can without error be believed of the greatness of Mary.

"If there were nothing else to take away our fear of going too far in the praises of Mary, St. Augustine's opinion would be enough. He declares that anything we may say in praise of Mary is little in comparison with what she deserves, because of her dignity as Mother of God."
